In 2016, the QEII Foundation and the QEII's Rehabilitation and Arthritis Centre celebrated the opening of The Grace Hansen Therapeutic Pool. A \$1-million gift by the Hansen-MacDonald family led the QEII Foundation's *Revitalizing Rehab* campaign, which saw the community come together and raise \$2.6-million to change the lives of rehabilitation patients.

“ FROM **the Heart**

I had my first heart attack when I was just 27 years old. I was physically fit and active, but I also had a family history of heart disease that I couldn't avoid.

We successfully managed the disease with medication for nearly two decades until danger struck again. After my second heart attack, there was a lot of talk of open-heart surgery which was scary for my family and me. Thankfully the QEII's heart health team recommended a safer and far less invasive solution.

An angioplasty procedure and three stents later, and I am feeling better than ever. This year, I'll walk my oldest daughter down the aisle for her wedding – an experience that wouldn't have been possible without the world-class heart health care provided by the QEII.

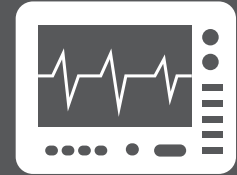
My care team gave me a second chance. Today, I'm grateful for every moment with my family.

At the QEII, we are very fortunate to have a Foundation - and donors like you - who value research and provide opportunities for researchers to ask questions and investigate important issues in health care.

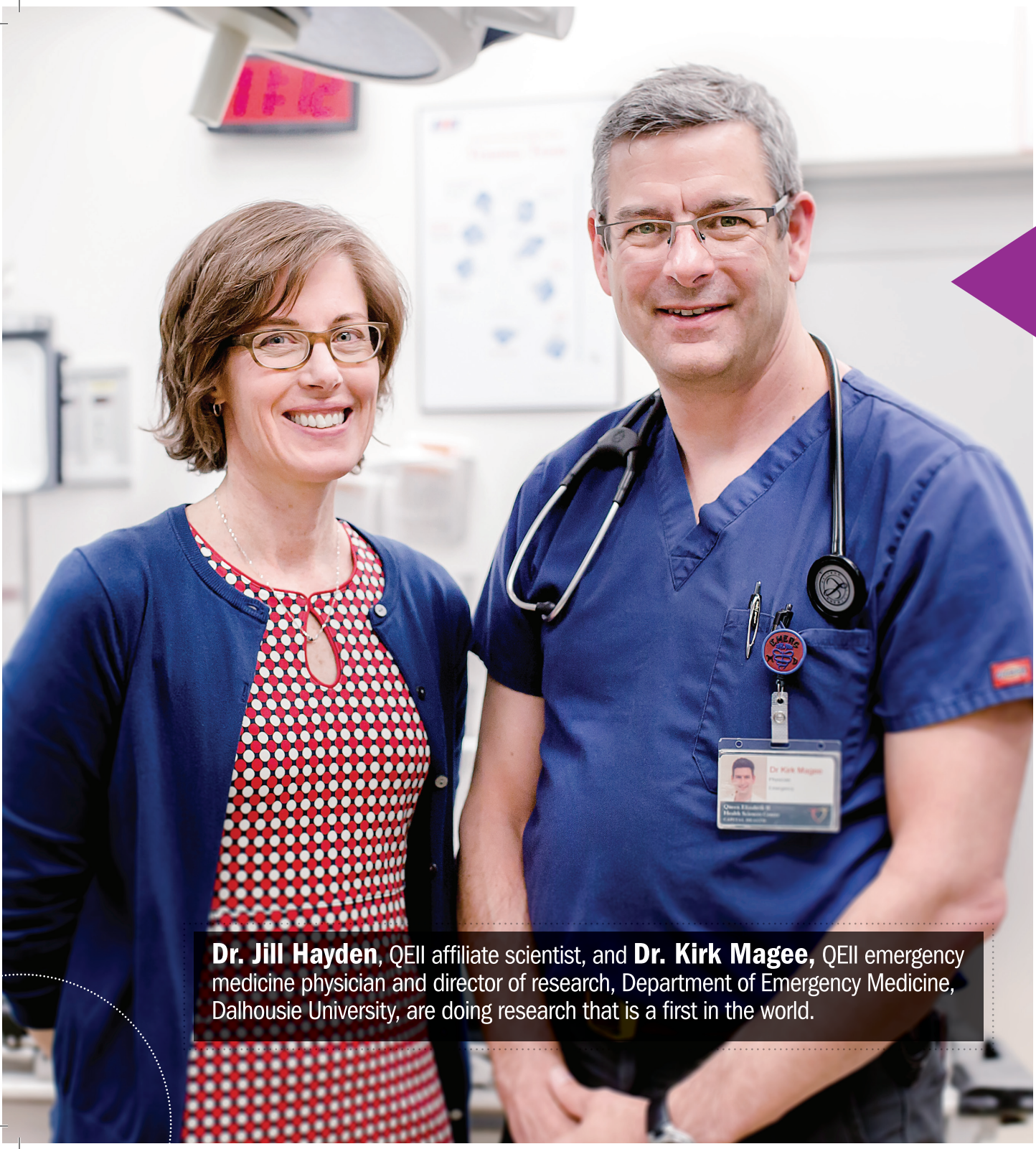

Dr. Jill Hayden, QEII affiliate scientist, and **Dr. Kirk Magee**, QEII emergency medicine physician and director of research, Department of Emergency Medicine, Dalhousie University, are doing research that is a first in the world.



Low back pain is the third most common condition seen at the emergency department; about 2,000 cases each year at the QEII. Through QEII Foundation *Translating Research Into Care* (TRIC) grants, and other national funding, Dr. Hayden and Dr. Magee are learning how to best implement diagnostic imaging guidelines for patients with acute low back pain. Their research will be a first in the world. In 2016-2017, thanks to the generosity of donors, \$300,000 was awarded for several TRIC grants to advance care.

“ GUARDIANS of the OR

We monitor patients breath by breath...or beat by beat, when we look at a patient's heart. Anesthesia machines and monitoring technology allow us to track every moment of a patient's experience in the operating room. This equipment is fundamental to the way we conduct anesthesia.

When I was a medical student in the 1980s, we measured a patient's blood pressure by cuff and listened to their heart, looking at their EKG. Over the next decade, things like the ability to monitor oxygenation and the carbon dioxide in every breath allowed for a greater measure of safety. Today, the monitors we have show us the amount of muscle relaxation and even the depth of anesthesia that patients experience.

Being an anesthesiologist is a lot like flying a plane. We're incredibly vigilant at the beginning and the end, shifting to cruise control for the duration of the procedure – unless we hit turbulence. And while turbulence can strike at any moment, our team has never been better equipped to respond.

**ANESTHESIA
TECHNOLOGY**

Anesthesia technology provides in-depth monitoring of patients at every moment during a procedure. Thanks to your generosity, complex information is made straightforward and is available at the fingertips of anesthesiologists, who, every day, contribute to lives saved at the QEII. Through the generosity of donors in 2016-2017, \$8.3-million supported equipment and technology advancements, like anesthesia technology, at the QEII.

On October 1, 2016, *Ride for Cancer*, powered by BMO Bank of Montreal, brought together a community of donors and riders to do something big for cancer. It was my first exercise adventure post-op and it felt amazing to finish the three-kilometre walk.

I've lost 100lbs since starting this program but my journey is far from over; I continue to push myself every day – last week I just picked up running!

“SEEING is believing”

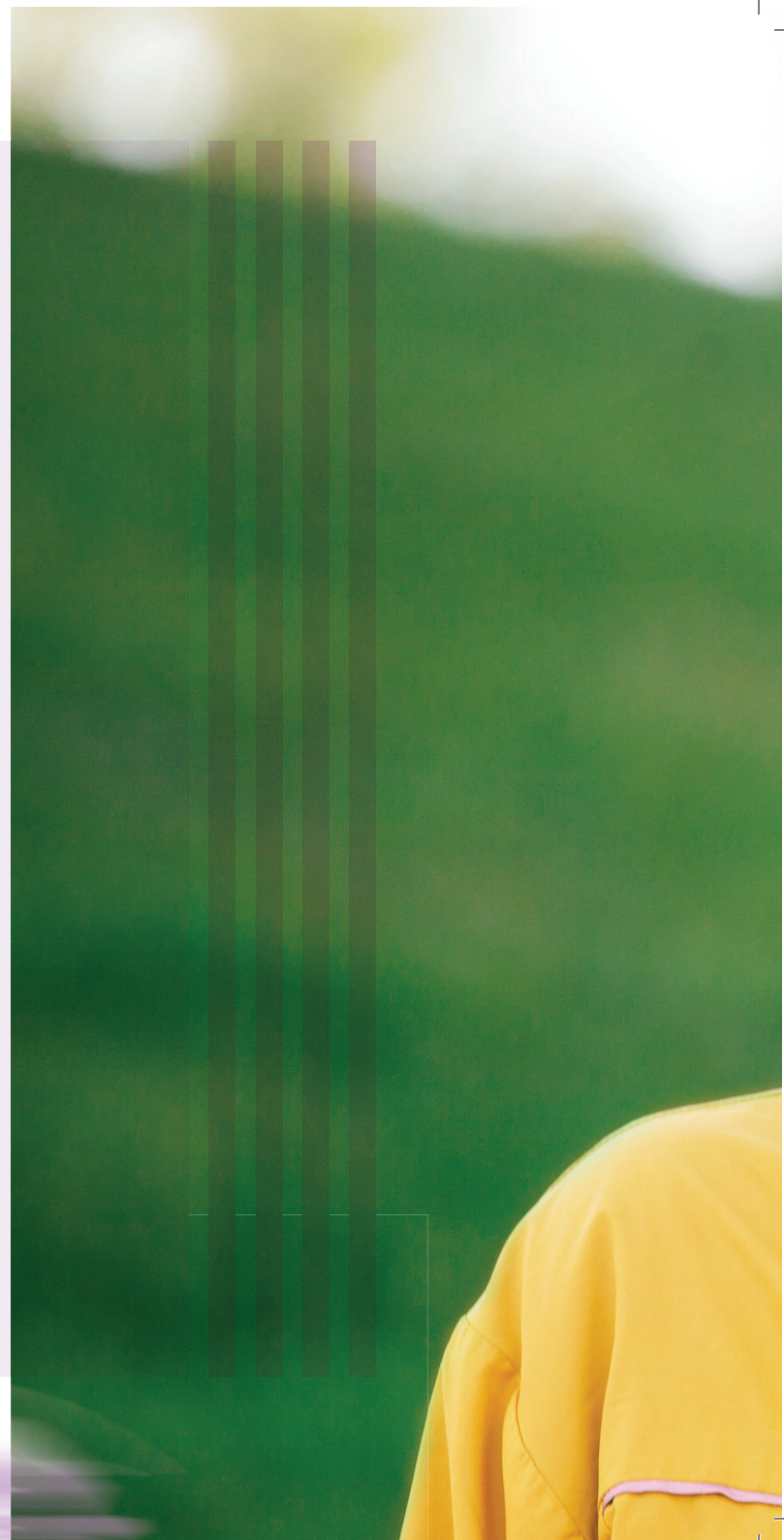

BEDSIDE ULTRASOUND

Point of Care Ultrasound (POCUS) provides a quick view inside the body, at the bedside. These compact devices bring advanced imaging capacity to the physician directly involved in making immediate, accurate decisions for patient care. It allows healthcare staff to see a patient's heart, lung function, and their blood vessels. It can help diagnose fluid in the abdominal cavity and blockages in the kidneys - without moving a patient from bed. POCUS increases patient safety, and ensures patients receive the care they need, sooner. The QEII is full of champions, like Marko, who help lead projects with the QEII Foundation that help change lives.

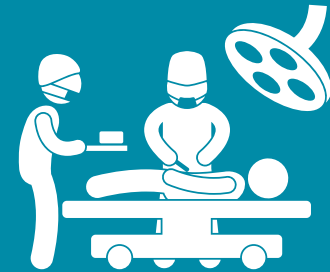
